## **Community Update - Forestry Building Renovation Project**

The University is restoring the Forestry Building to become an inner-city learning and teaching hub that will host Business and Economics, Humanities and Social Sciences, professional staff teams and community activities. With construction led by Hansen Yuncken, it's due for occupation in 2026.

## **Upcoming construction works**

Construction permits are in place with City of Hobart for **piling works to create the foundations for the bridge walkway connection** between Brisbane and Melville Streets. Any **intermittent noisy works** will be undertaken between **7am – 5pm Monday – Friday**. No extra lane closures will be required.

Planned commencement of works is **15 November 2024 for 2-3 weeks.** Please take care when travelling around the area and observe workers and signage in place. All local businesses will be open as normal. We thank you for your patience.
