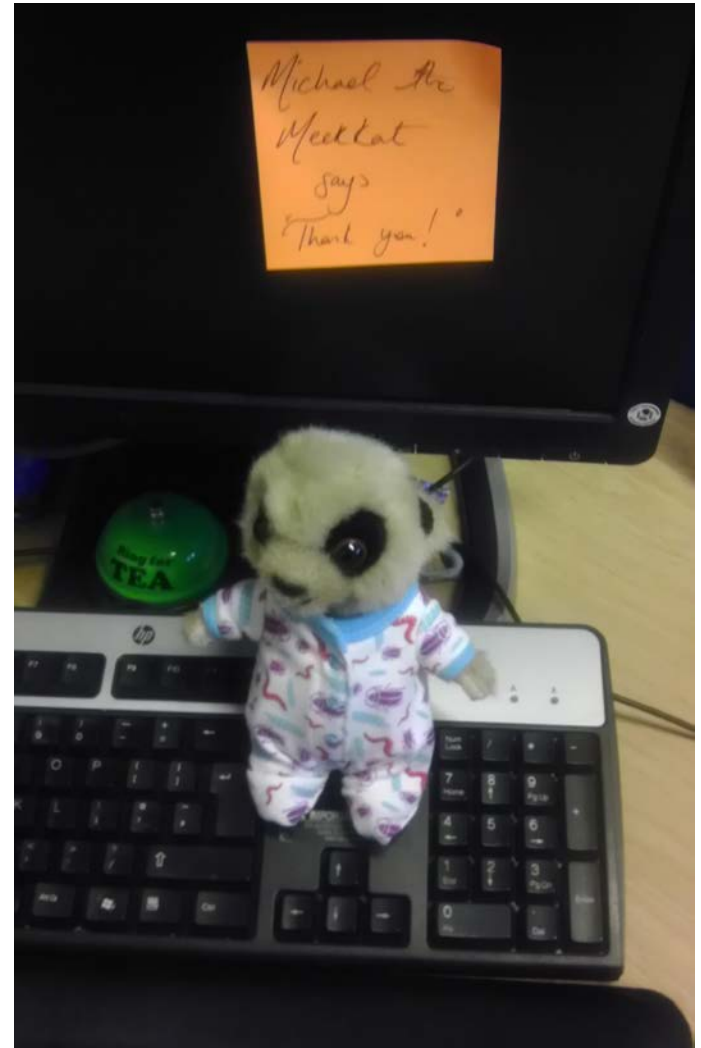

Students used union branded signs to show their university who was behind the campaign – 50 photos were uploaded on one day of action!

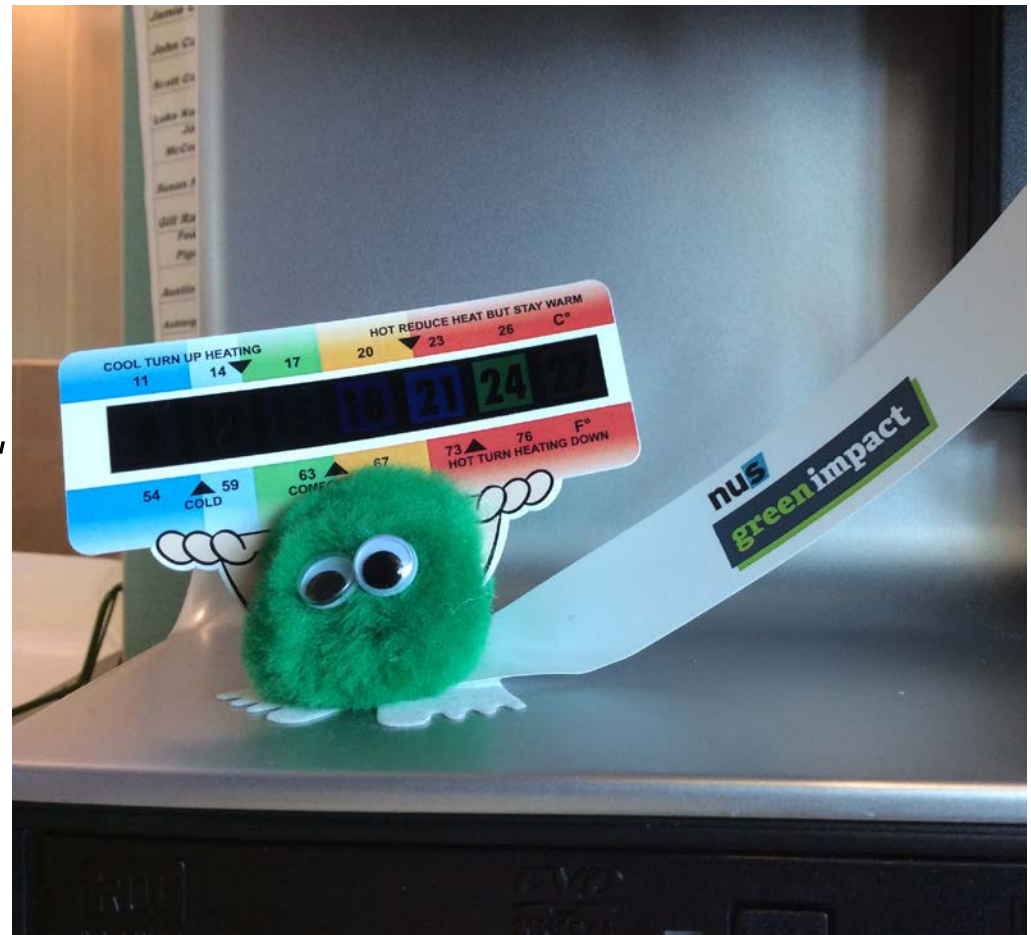

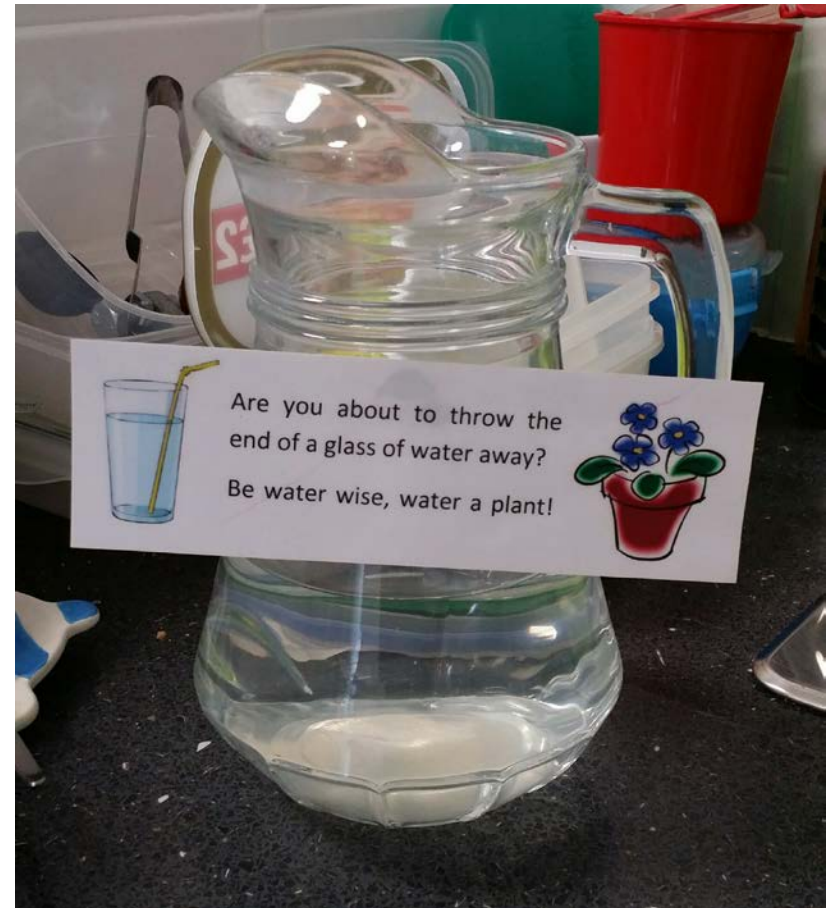

At LSE clocks were made out of recycled signage from around campus to give to the Green Impact winners.

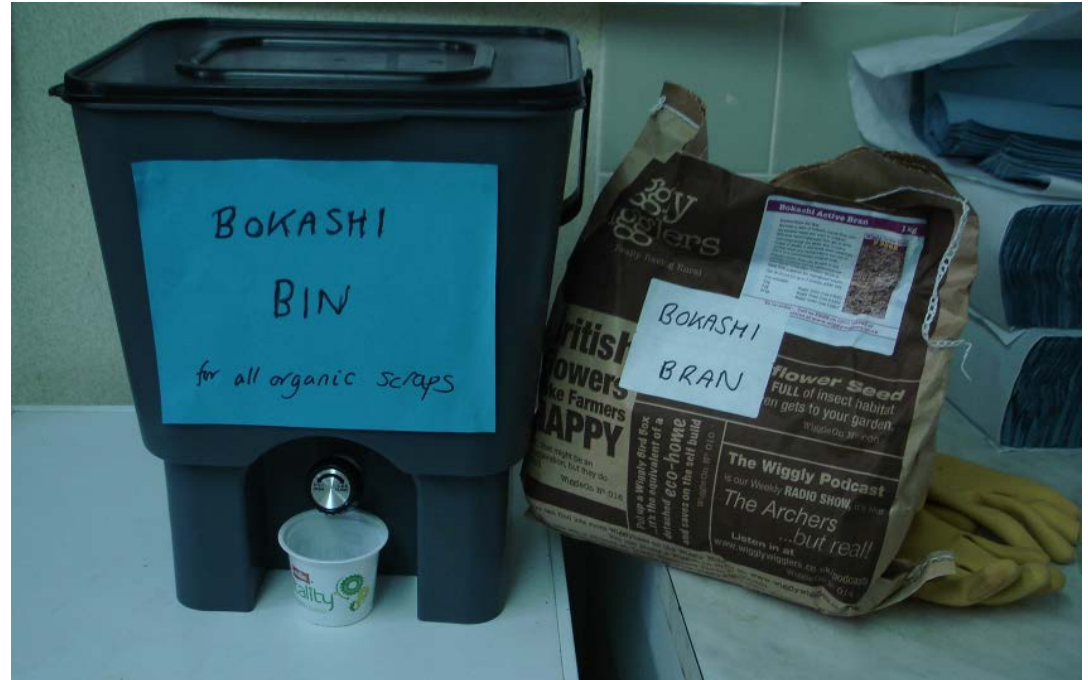

A Bokashi Bin at the University of Worcester – it does the same as a wormery but without the worms!

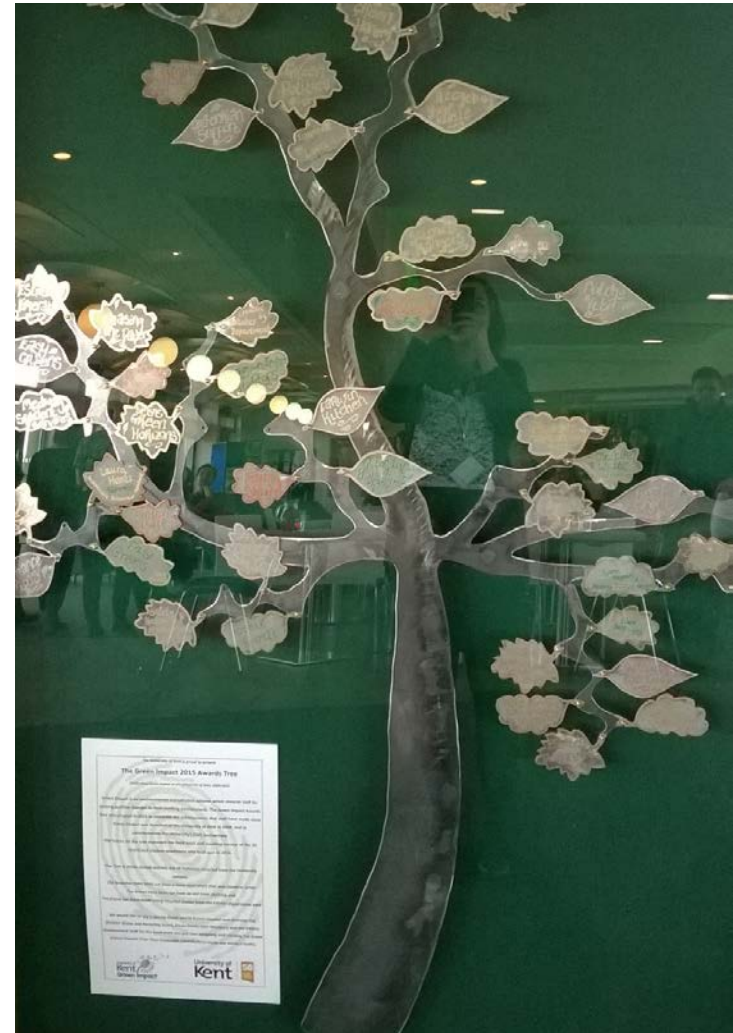
